



Camping Guidelines, Rules & Cancellation Policy

Arizona Bike Week, The City of Scottsdale and WestWorld management shall enforce the following rules and regulations. These rules and regulations are to be observed by all users of the WestWorld facilities.

GENERAL RULES

- RV and tent camping guests are required to register with Arizona Bike Week.
- The facilities are utilized at the user's own risk. Arizona Bike Week, WestWorld, and The City of Scottsdale are not responsible for any personal injury or personal property damage on or going to or from the premises.
- Your campsite reservation includes two Rally Passes. Additional guests visiting or staying in the campgrounds will need to purchase admission passes.
- Your campsite reservation includes five nights of camping, beginning Wednesday, March 31, with checkout by 11:00 a.m. on Monday, April 5.
- Arizona Bike Week, WestWorld and The City of Scottsdale shall not be liable for lost, stolen or damaged personal property. Any property left on-site at WestWorld that remains unclaimed after ninety (90) days may be disposed of or otherwise handled at the discretion of Arizona Bike Week. Arizona Bike Week, WestWorld, and The City of Scottsdale will not be responsible for any property left behind by attendees.
- Users are responsible for any damage caused to the facilities or surrounding property, excluding normal wear and tear. Arizona Bike Week, WestWorld, and The City of Scottsdale reserve the right to repair such damage and invoice the responsible party for the associated costs.
- Any accident, regardless of nature, is to be immediately reported to Arizona Bike Week management.
- Sales and distribution of food and beverage or other commercial activities are not allowed without the express written consent of Arizona Bike Week and the completion of written contractual agreements.
- Any unauthorized use of facilities and/or utilities is prohibited.
- Open cooking or campfires are prohibited. Contained gas or charcoal outdoor cooking devices are acceptable.

- Disposal of trash or solid waste materials is allowed in designated areas or receptacles only. Pumping services are to be provided by Arizona Bike Week contracted service providers only. No other pumping service will be allowed.
- Firearms are not permitted on WestWorld's property. Federal laws apply.
- Fireworks or explosives cannot be brought onto WestWorld property.
- Pets are to be kept on leashes at all times. You must clean up after your pet.
- Quiet hours begin at 11:00 PM and continue until 7:00 AM. Excessive noise, amplified music, generators operating in a disruptive manner, or other disturbances that interfere with neighboring campers may result in corrective action or removal from the property.
- Overnight parking is not permitted except in RV camping areas or other specifically designated locations with the correct parking pass. A valid camping reservation is required to remain on the premises overnight.
- Tent camping is permitted only in the designated tent area. No tents are allowed in the RV lots. No vehicles are allowed in the tent camping area.
- Area traffic and parking signs are to be observed at all times, including posted speed limits. The posted speed limit on the main access road is 25 mph. All other roads are posted at 15 mph.
- Designated fire lanes are to be kept clear at all times. Vehicles in unauthorized areas will be towed at the owner's expense.
- WestWorld visitors and facility users may not post or exhibit any printed material such as posters, signs or advertisements without prior written approval by Arizona Bike Week management.
- Arizona Bike Week management reserves the right to remove from the property any individual displaying disorderly conduct, public nudity, intoxication, violations of these Rules & Regulations, excessive noise, or other disruptive behavior. If you are evicted from the property, there will be NO REFUNDS issued.
- Facility users and visitors must comply with all environmental laws, rules and regulations.
- Golf carts are permitted in camping and outdoor vending areas and must be operated in a safe and responsible manner. Arizona Bike Week reserves the right to restrict or revoke golf cart privileges for unsafe operation.
- Each campsite includes one vehicle parking pass. Additional vehicles or vehicle trailers will be required to purchase an additional vehicle pass. Motorcycles do not require a pass to park at WestWorld.
- Arizona Bike Week, WestWorld, and The City of Scottsdale reserve the right to use the name, image, photograph, likeness or any other reproduction, taken or acquired, of any visitor or facility user, for publicity purposes of Arizona Bike Week, WestWorld, and The City of Scottsdale without notifying or compensating individuals therein.
- Arizona Bike Week reserves the right to relocate campsites when necessary for operational, safety, emergency access, construction, utility, production, or event-related requirements. Every effort will be made to provide a comparable campsite.
- Campsite reservations may not be transferred, assigned, sold, or resold without prior written approval from Arizona Bike Week management.

- Arizona Bike Week reserves the right to refuse admission or remove any person whose conduct is deemed unsafe, disruptive, unlawful, or detrimental to the enjoyment of other attendees.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If you register and pay for a tent or RV campsite and later determine that you are unable to attend, Arizona Bike Week® will issue a refund, less a 5% processing fee, if written notice is received on or before March 3, 2027.

Written cancellations received after March 3, 2027 and on or before March 17, 2027 will receive a 50% refund of campsite fees paid.

No refunds will be issued for cancellation requests received after March 17, 2027.

All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing.

If Arizona Bike Week is postponed, all campsite reservations and associated payments will automatically transfer to the rescheduled event dates.

If Arizona Bike Week is canceled and not rescheduled, Arizona Bike Week will communicate applicable refund procedures to registered campers in accordance with applicable law and event policies.

Arizona Bike Week reserves the right to cancel campsite reservations if a purchaser is found to be selling or transferring campsites for profit or in violation of event policies. In such cases, the purchaser may forfeit future rebooking privileges, including any first right of refusal associated with previously reserved campsites.
